be able to step on the same path with our service users and help them solve various problems they face in today's society.



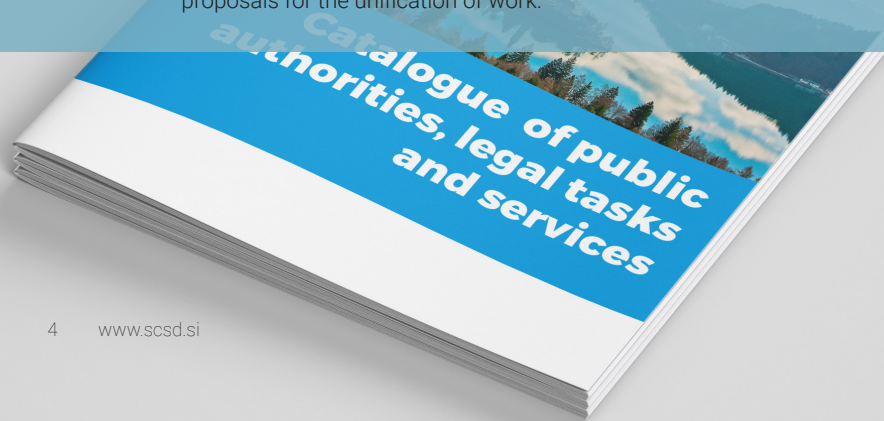

- we determine the standards and norms for carrying out individual types of tasks,
- we work in an organized manner to advocate for the common interests of our members in the formulation of legislation,
- we take initiatives and participate in the formulation and changes of standards and norms of social protection services,
- we publish the professional newsletter and formulate proposals for the unification of work.

EVENT ORGANIZATION

We organize various forms of meetings, professional lectures, courses, cooperation projects, exchange of experience, lectures about the professional implementation of various professional activities of CSW.
